Qualifications: MDiv or equivalent; 5+ years as a priest within an Anglican parish.

Theology: Committed to historic and catholic Christianity; forming Great Tradition¹ Christians over making Anglicans; deeply committed to a sacramental imagination; practices and articulates a monastic-inspired spirituality; commitment to a traditional, biblical view of Christian sexuality and able to clearly articulate and winsomely express these convictions.

Pastoral Style: Warm, pastoral, non-anxious presence; adept at handling the complexities of an ever-changing urban congregation (transiency, urban busyness, diversity, etc.); able to pastor people across a political / ideological spectrum; adept at handling the complexities of living in a post-Christian context.

Leadership Style: Collaborative, visionary leader, who leads from a posture of humility, who is able to deepen our regional vision of ministry.

Churchmanship: Convictional preference for a liturgically-oriented Anglican church; views High Church forms (vestments, manual acts, emphasizing the Liturgical calendar, smells & bells, etc.) as inherently laden with missional potential, while comfortable seeing High Church forms combined with contemporary aesthetics ("ancient-future" worship); three-stream (Sacrament, Scripture, Spirit).

Teaching Emphases: Compelling and insightfully biblical preacher / teacher who has a christocentric approach; holistic Christian formation according to the Great Tradition; celebrating catechetical formation and monasticism as a rich resource / tradition of formation.
