

Independent Investigation of Churches for the Sake of Others

Summary of Investigation

March 6, 2025



Summary of Investigation

In January of 2022, leaders at Christ Our King Anglican Church in Glendora, California, received allegations of sexual misconduct by Rev. George Amimo, a licensed volunteer priest at Christ Our King Anglican Church in Glendora, CA. These allegations were communicated by the leaders to the church's denomination, Churches for the Sake of Others ("C4SO"). Thereafter, C4SO requested and received a written account of the sexual misconduct allegations from the Reporting Victim ("RV"). On March 10, 2022, Rev. George Amimo was placed on administrative leave.¹ On March 31, 2022, C4SO engaged Godly Response to Abuse in the Christian Environment ("GRACE") to conduct an independent investigation into these allegations.² The scope of GRACE's investigation was as follows:

GRACE will investigate allegations of sexual misconduct by Rev. George Amimo, licensed volunteer priest at Christ Our King Anglican Church in Glendora, CA. If misconduct is found to have occurred, GRACE shall also seek to learn if it was a part of a pattern of misconduct. GRACE will seek to identify any significant contributing factors and root causes for any misconduct found, including those that might be related to the organizational climate, decisions, or structures of Christ Our King and/or the Diocese of Churches for the Sake of Others.

GRACE's methodology included conducting five witness interviews, a tour of the location in which the allegations were reported to have taken place, regular communication with RV, and preparation of a comprehensive final report. Rev. George Amimo did not respond to multiple interview requests by GRACE, and no longer holds a position within the C4SO denomination.

In accordance with GRACE's standard practice, RV received a copy of her interview transcript for review shortly after her interview in June 2022. On November 3, 2022, RV informed GRACE of her preference that her statements not be included in the report without her prior review, a request she reiterated in multiple follow-up communications. In recognition of RV's wishes, GRACE agreed to provide additional time for her to review the transcript. Throughout this period, GRACE maintained periodic communication with RV, offering opportunities to review the transcript in person with a GRACE investigator, a list of topics from her transcript intended for inclusion in the final report, and a relevant portion of the final report containing her statements. As GRACE did not receive feedback or confirmation from RV regarding the inclusion of her statements without prior review, the decision was made to close the investigation on March 1, 2025, and forgo issuing a comprehensive final report that incorporated RV's statements.
